Sign up for Spring Planting Events!

Sign-up is now open for our April Planting Event. We are looking for 1,500 volunteers to help us plant 4,500+ native trees and shrubs.

Saturday, April 26, 2025: Event Set-up Day

- From 8 AM to 12 PM, help us move trees and equipment into the field.
- At 12:30 PM, Planting Coach Training Session for new Coaches

Sunday, April 27, 2025: Planting Day

- 9 AM to 12 PM - Planting Session #1
- 1 PM to 4 PM - Planting Session #2

Information for Signing Up

1. Each adult must register and have a ticket in their own name. Please register for one "Adult 18+ Tree Planter Ticket". If you are taking part with a group, identify your "group name". If you are bringing minors under 18, identify the number of minors.
2. If you are under 18, adult supervision is required. The supervising adult will identify the number of minors on their ticket. Minors under 18 do not need their own ticket.
3. Planting Coaches: If you have planted with us before, we encourage you to consider signing up as a planting coach. Planting coaches lead small groups of volunteers and demonstrate proper planting technique. Training for all new Planting Coaches is provided and will take place on Saturday, April 26 (12:30 PM) at Bruce's Mill Conservation Park. If you are interested, please sign up for Planting Coach Training (April 26th) and then sign up as a Planting Coach at the planting events. A member of our group will follow-up with further information upon sign-up.
4. Corporate/Community Groups - for large groups, we encourage you to identify one or several Planting Coaches. These Planting Coaches would take the training on April 26th and then be able to teach your entire group on April 27th.

What you need to know to plan for the event:

1. Please bring your own shovel and 5-gallon bucket if you have one. We will have extras that you can borrow.
2. No experience is required. One of our volunteers will teach everyone proper tree planting technique at the start of the event.
3. Free parking and washroom facilities are available at Bruce's Mill Conservation Park.
4. Refreshments will be served from 12 PM to 1 PM. Picnic tables are available for everyone to use before or after their session.

Other Events we are planning for this Spring

Save the Date for two planting events in May and June. We will be planting at previous sites in Markham to further expand forest and pollinator habitats.

Saturday, May 10, 2025 - Austin Drive Park, Tree Planting Event

Saturday, June 7, 2025 - Monarch Park, Wildflower Event
